JOB PURPOSE: Responsible for proper operation, maintenance and inspection of mail and auxiliary machinery, and electrical, mechanical and safety equipment under safety policy of the Ministry

MAIN DUTIES AND OUTCOMES:

- 1.1 Supervise the engine room with personnel and give advice as required
- 1.2 Improve performance and efficiency of engine room work team
- 2.1 Maintain, inspect, and operate the boats and make sure that it's always safe and ready in case of an emergency.
- 3.1 Keep and maintain a trip and fuel log, a maintenance log, and provide periodic maintenance,
- 3.2 Arranging, preparing and recording of machinery survey
- 3.3 Request RMI to purchase spare parts and consumables, e.g., floatation devices, flares, etc.
- 3.4 Inspect and ensure that safety equipment is operational, e.g., floatation devices, flares, etc.
- 3.5 Always ensure passenger safety, number of passengers must not exceed the number of floatation devices

- 3.6 Ensure that medical some personnel are always available during emergency trips
- 4.1 Draw up training orientation program for engine room cadets.
- 4.2 Ensure that sufficient stock is (bunker, fuel oil, diesel oil, main engine lube oil, cylinder oil, and other lube oils and chemicals) in case of any unpredictable situation (E.g. bad weather, engine breakdown at sea, delay of voyage, unavailable of port bunker and service and etc...)
